The funds will be used to further increase our foreign language program, increasing access to Spanish II, including curriculum, for foster youth, low-income students and English learners.

A summer program was added to our offerings in the summer of 2021 specifically to provide the opportunity for students to retake courses in which they received a "D", "F", or "Fail" grade in 2020 spring semester or the 2020-2021 school year. All 24 students had the opportunity to participate in the summer program.

21-22 LCAP Goal #3 is a focus goal to "Increase the % of students who meet a-g requirements and the % of students completing college credit courses over the next two years to better prepare students for college and career pathways." This plan supports actions steps 1 and 2 to increase A-G access, courses, and foreign language. The LCAP goals budgeted for part of the cost to employ a highly-qualified Spanish teacher. These funds will be used to pay for the rest of the cost of the employee, and additional curriculum, in order to fund adding access to Spanish II.
