A description of how the funds will be used to increase or improve services for foster youth, low-income students, and English learners to improve A-G eligibility

Funds will be used to allow students the opportunity to take or retake a-g level courses with staff support either online through outside sources or virtual with JCS-Pine Valley or sister school staff. Math tutoring will be available to assist students with reaching the Math III requirement. Will also add additional a-g elective courses at the academy program to include a rotation of Art Appreciation and Psychology.

A description of the extent to which all students, including foster youth, low-income students, and English learners, will have access to A-G courses approved by the University of California.

All students are encouraged to enroll in a-g courses. Tutoring is available to all students including foster youth, low-income students, and English learners with options for longer days, after school meals, tutoring, and language support as needed.

The number of students who were identified for opportunities to retake A-G approved courses in which they received a “D”, “F”, or “Fail” grade in the 2020 spring semester or the 2020-21 school year and a description of the method used to offer the opportunity retake courses.

Number of Students: 4

One student will retake a whole year of classes and graduate a year later. 3 students will retake courses either within their regular schedule, online, or independent study with teacher support outside the normal day schedule. These options will include tutoring time as needed.
