Art Supplies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Supplies must be appropriate for age, course of study, and what a typical school would provide to a student in that grade level</li><li>• Order quantities must be appropriate to the student's needs and course of study</li><li>• Please use JCS-prepared art kits whenever possible</li></ul>
Clothing	No clothing
Curriculum	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• No multi-year curriculum</li><li>• No curriculum for future years</li><li>• Please refer to the Educational Materials Policy for information about religious/sectarian material.</li><li>• No material that a student plans to resell, such as for a student created business</li><li>• No one time use CDs over \$25</li></ul>
Dangerous Material	No dangerous material of any kind including: chemicals, knives, and rocket engines
Furniture	No furniture. For example: tables, easels, lamps, large white boards and music stands.
Hard Assets	No hard assets including: cameras, musical instruments, computers, printers, electronics, and potter's wheels. JCS stocks calculators, microscopes, and globes. Currently out of stock items can be ordered using EUs. Ordered items must be what are normally stocked.
Office Supplies	Supplies needed to support the student's education such as paper, pencils, one ink cartridge per student per semester, and basic necessities <b>may be ordered</b> . Order quantities must be appropriate to the student's needs and course of study.
Toys	No toys, including Legos (if your student's lesson requires the use of Legos or another similar item, please let your EF know).
