Funds will be used to allow students the opportunity to take A-G level courses through school affiliated educational partners such as Edgenuity, Odysseyware, and BYU. This will improve their A-G eligibility because they can take specialized courses such as foreign language that JCS does not offer through its high school specialist program.

All students are encouraged to enroll in A-G courses in order to meet expectations for College and Career Readiness. Tutoring, free meals, personal technology (Chromebooks), school and home internet access, and language support are available to support all students.
